Post-doctoral Fellowship in Fluvial Processes at Saint Louis University

A post-doctoral fellowship is available to study physical processes at large river confluences or the sustainability of river-reservoir systems. The fellow will have a high level of both flexibility and responsibility in developing the research project. The fellow will be expected to interact productively with research sponsors and stakeholders, graduate students, and undergraduate students. Teaching opportunities will also be available, at the option of the fellow. This is a 2-year position with the second year of support contingent upon successful performance during the first year.
